PREFERENCE RULES OF ORIGIN

This half day course takes an in-depth look at the rules of origin, providing clarity between preference origin and non-preference origin and how to establish where goods originate "officially".

Responsibilities as an importer and exporter

Delegates will have gained the knowledge of how origin is established, how to complete the relevant documentation and the internal requirements to support the process.

This course is suitable for all involved in making applications for EUR1 and ATR documents, Shipping, Accounts, Purchasing and Freight Forwarders.
